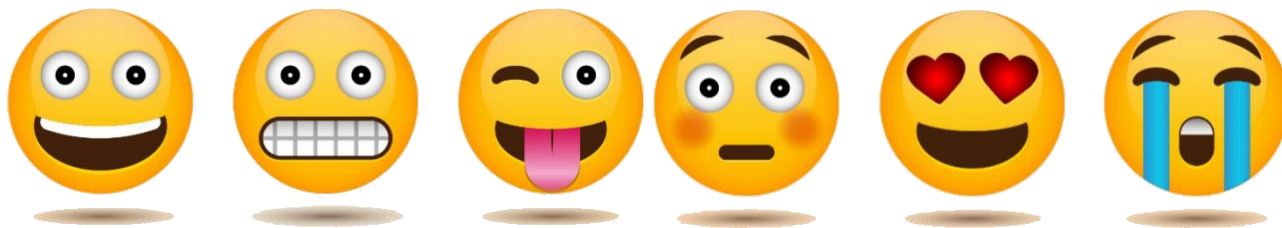


Expressing yourself through Emojis

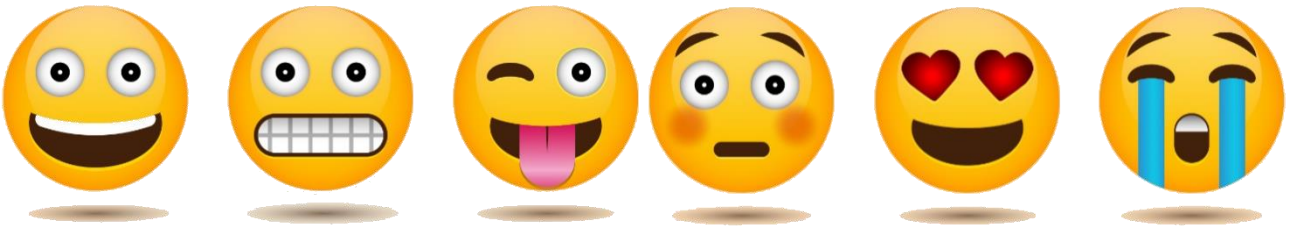
Students' ages: 14-16

Students' level: Upper Intermediate

Assumptions: Students are supposed to have already studied Feeling Adjectives and the Simple Present tense.

Stage	Time	Objective(s): Ss are supposed to	Material	Description
Pre-listening activity	10min	- Identify some emojis meanings.	- Whiteboard; - Marker; - Flashcards with emoji pictures.	- Teacher (T) asks students (Ss) what emojis are, if they use them, and what the most popular ones are. - T presents some emoji pictures (see the ANNEX) to Ss and asks them for the meaning. - Ss tell the emoji's meaning according to what they see in the pictures.
While-listening activity	15min	- Identify main points of the movie plot.	- Speakers; - Video of the Emoji Movie Trailer ; - Worksheet.	- Ss watch the Emoji Movie trailer and answer some questions about the movie's characters (see the Worksheet). T presents and clarifies such questions before playing the video. -Ss tell the class their answers, and T provides correction if necessary.
Post-listening activity	20min	- Make comments using emojis.	- Flashcards with emoji pictures.	- In pairs, Ss comment on a situation they have gone through (sad, funny, surprising, etc.): Student A tells the situation and student B reacts by using emojis (see the ANNEX).
