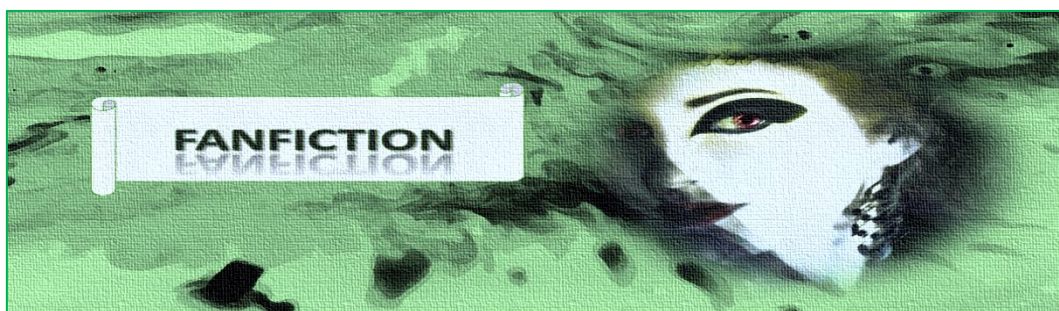


**WRITING ACTIVITY by Nathália Fernandes Negrão (TEAM member). Oct. 21, 2018.**

Students' ages: 16 – 18

Students' level: Advanced

Assumptions: Students are supposed to have already studied the Simple Past tense; and the characteristics of the genre fanfiction (this activity is supposed to be used after the [FANFICTION SPEAKING ACTIVITY](#) you can find here, on team.ufpa.br).

Stage	Time	Objective(s): Ss are supposed to	Material	Description
Pre-writing activity	5min	- Tell characteristics of the genre fanfiction.	- Board; - Marker.	- Teacher (T) asks students (Ss) what they remember about the characteristics of the genre fanfiction and writes their answers on the board while they speak.  ✓ If necessary, T adds more information about the genre.
While-writing activity	30min	- Write a one-shot fanfiction using the Simple Past tense;  - Practice peer correction.	- Sheets of paper; - Pens/pencils.	- T tells Ss that, in pairs (the same pairs from the previous <a href="#">FANFICTION SPEAKING ACTIVITY</a> in which they already produced an introductory paragraph), they are going to continue writing their one-shot fanfiction which they started in a previous class, using the Simple Past tense.  ✓ Two or three more paragraphs are enough to finish their story.

				<p>- After finishing their texts, Ss get in pairs for peer correction: each student is supposed to read the other classmate's text and give his/her opinion concerning text organization, lexical-grammatical choices, etc.</p>
Post-writing activity	10min	- Practice rewriting and editing.	<p>- Sheets of paper; - Pens/pencils; - Computer with Internet connection or cork/paper board.</p>	<p>- While Ss continue their peer correction, T goes to each Ss' desk to clarify specific details in their texts.</p> <p>- Ss take their fanfics home to finish and edit the final details and bring them the next class.</p> <p>✓ If time is allowed, T can reserve 10 min from the next three or four classes so Ss can continue the rewriting and corrections in class until Ss get to the final version of their work.</p> <p>- The final versions of the fanfics can be either posted online or fixed on a cork/paper board as a mural to be exhibited in the classroom or in the school hall.</p> <p>✓ Suggestions of websites where the fanfictions can be posted for free: - Fanfiction.net (<a href="https://www.fanfiction.net/">https://www.fanfiction.net/</a>) - Tumblr.com (<a href="https://www.tumblr.com/">https://www.tumblr.com/</a>)</p> <p>Note: ✓ To post on both websites it is necessary to register using an e-mail address; ✓ Both platforms can be accessed by their apps on smartphones.</p>
