



1. Title: **How do they do it? Describing Actions – Adverbs of Manner Game** by Danyelle Moraes Souza da Silva (TEAM member). Nov 24, 2021.
2. Players:
 - Number: unlimited number of players. It can be played individually or in groups.
 - Ages: 12 +
 - Level: lower intermediate.
3. Time: about 10 min.
4. Goal: helping students to describe actions using adverbs of manner.
5. About the game: the players' objective is to identify the appropriate adverb of manner for each context.
6. Rules:
 - For the individual player:
Access the link for the game on the *Wordwall* platform.
Write your name.
Click on the start game button.
Answer the questions in the game by clicking in the appropriate adverb of manner.
The game is over when all the questions have been answered.
 - For groups of players:
Access the link for the game on the *Wordwall* platform.
Write the name of the group.
Click on the start game button.

Answer the questions in the game by clicking in the appropriate adverb of manner.
The game is over when all the questions have been answered.
The group with most game points win.
